OVERVIEW OF THE PROGRAMME

How the club works:

- We encourage learners to join and manage the club as their own.
- They select a maximum of 15 learners per annum to run the club.
- Each member will wear a pinon badge on their school blazer and receive a club T-shirt, fleece jacket and information brochure.
- The club also receive large club posters to use for promoting the club.

Members implement a recycling program at their school:

- Set up recycling bins, host information sessions, promote and facilitate Green Club activities.
- Participate in the quarterly inter-school recycling competitions and market days.
- Promote the club in such a way that the learners manage the club and keep it going as an extramural activity within the school, being part of the schools' overall cultural and environmental objectives.

PROGRAMME DETAILS

Sponsorship funds launch and maintain the clubs for 12 months. We introduce waste management and recycling workshops for the club members (Learners) to encourage green-conscious practices. By hosting competitions and finding sponsors the members are equipped with the skills to continue with the club post-sponsorship. Within these club activities the members are also exposed to valuable life lessons.
