OUTCOMES:

An initiative to establish recycling clubs focused on schools in rural communities. Green Clubs create a clean, safe and healthy environment where children participate in fun and educational, green-conscious activities. Cleaning up the environment while having fun and transferring positive environmental practices that are both healthy and educational. Green Clubs can also become a fundraising activity for the schools.

IMPLEMENTATION:

- Implemented over 12 months & designed to be led by the club members.
- Club hosts competitions, up-cycling workshops and events.
- Interactive activities uses recycling as opportunity for young people to practice teamwork, leadership skills and healthy competition.
- Learners continue with the Green Club in their school for as long as they can recruit new members and maintain interest in & income from the club.
